



PROTECTION CONCEPT UNDER COVID-19 OF INTERCULTURAL TUESDAYS INTERACT IN AFFOLTERN

1. HAND HYGIENE

All ETKulturs team members, volunteers and participants clean their hands regularly. Avoid touching surfaces and objects.

Measures

ETKulturs team members and volunteers* regularly clean their hands with hand disinfectant or, where possible, with soap and water.

All visitors are required to wash their hands thoroughly or disinfect them when entering the tithe house. A hand hygiene station will be set up at the entrance.

2. KEEP DISTANCE

ETKulturs team members, volunteers and participants keep a distance of 2 m from each other and from other people. In cases where this distance cannot be maintained, the ETKulturs Team, volunteers should wear protective masks or extra protection and participants should provide their contact details.

Measures

If possible, the distance to other persons is ensured by means of (makeshift) storage space and/or floor markings.

The participants should avoid hugs and other physical contact.

Where the distance of 2 meters cannot be maintained, a plexiglass device is installed. If this is not possible, the ETKulturs team and volunteers will provide masks or protective visors if necessary.

In the case of activities requiring a proximity of less than 2 metres, participants must wear protective masks and appeal to their common sense.

The activities of the Intercultural Tuesday are conducted at tables with groups of up to 4 people.

The FOPH's recommendations on distance do not apply to children and between persons living in the same household.

3. CLEANING

Regular cleaning of surfaces as required and objects after use, especially if they are touched by several persons.

Measures

Surfaces and objects (pens, work surfaces, clipboards, wool, etc.) are regularly cleaned with a cleaning or disinfecting agent.

Ventilate: The common areas are ventilated regularly.

4. FOOD SALE - INTERCULTURAL COFFEE BREAK

Strict hygiene standards are applied when preparing food or coffee for consumption in the Zehntenhaus.

Measures

The person preparing sandwiches or cakes should wear a mask and gloves.

The cakes or sandwiches must be delivered packed to the cafeteria Zehntenhaus.

The person who participates in coffee and food sales must wear gloves and a protective mask at all times.

The utensils used should be disposable from cardboard and napkins.

The surfaces should be continuously disinfected.



5. SPECIFIC WORK SITUATIONS

Taking into account specific aspects of work and work situations in order to to ensure protection.

Measures

Events are allowed up to a maximum of 300 participants

Events in the interiors of the Zehntenhaus are permitted up to a maximum of 30 participants

Each activity held on intercultural Tuesdays should have its own contact list for those who have attended

6. PARTICULARLY VULNERABLE PERSONS

Persons at particular risk continue to comply with the FOPH's protective measures and stay at home whenever possible. The protection of particularly endangered employees is regulated in detail in COVID-19 Ordinance 2.

Measures

No team members shall be appointed who belong to the group of persons particularly at risk.

If a member of the team belonging to a risk group decides to participate, he/she does so at his/her own risk and must observe distance and hygiene measures.

7. COVID-19 SICK PERSONS

Send persons with symptoms of illness home with a hygiene mask and inform them to follow the instructions of the FOPH (see www.bag.admin.ch/isolation-und-quarantaene)

Measures

Team members, volunteers* and participants* with symptoms of illness are sent home with a hygiene mask and asked to follow the FOPH's instructions.

8. INFORMATION

Inform the concerned persons of the measures taken.

Measures

The team members, volunteers and participants are informed about the distance and hygiene measures to be observed.

If a stand is available, the protective measures in accordance with the FOPH are displayed.
